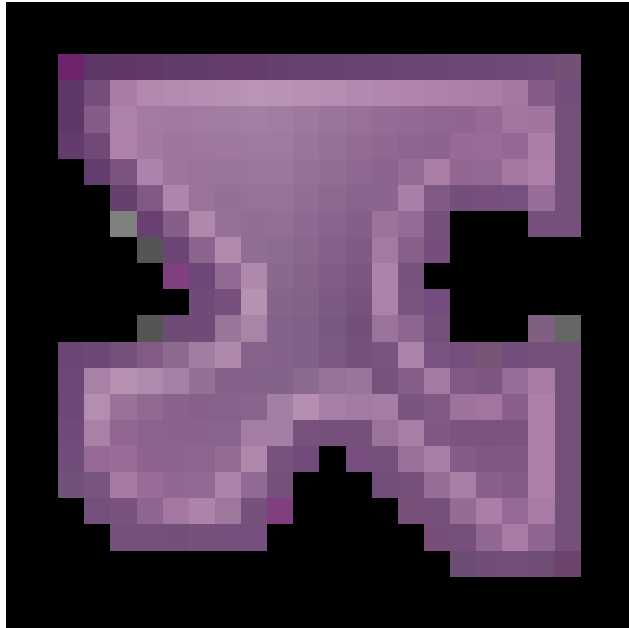

Listen to Katherine Fas, a teacher educator, as she talks about how she has used scaffolding to support pupils and how she gradually reduced it over time.



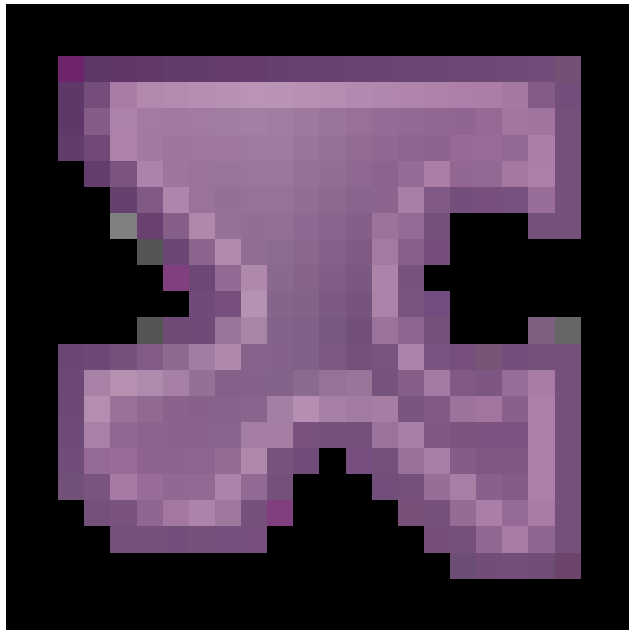

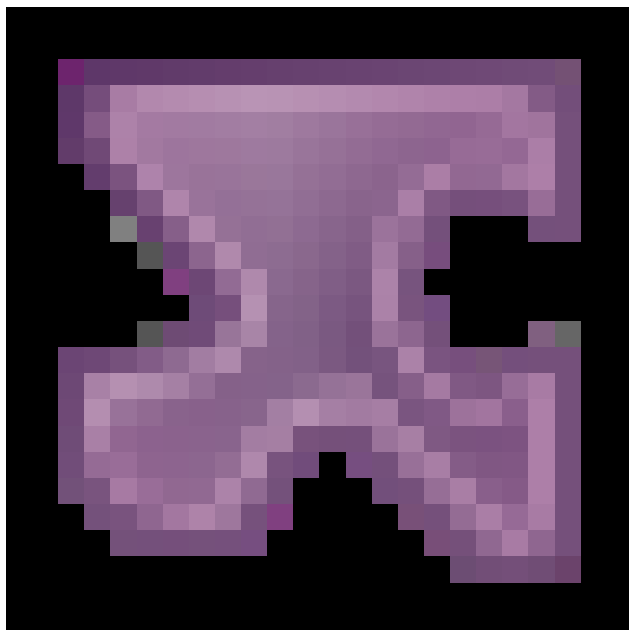

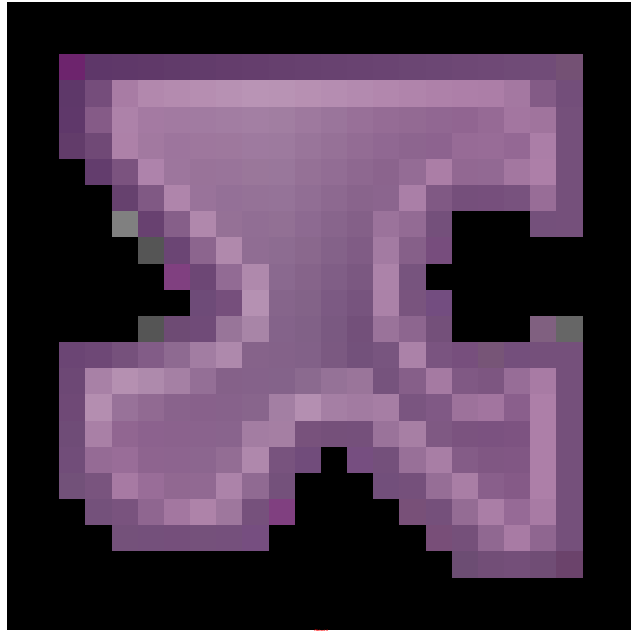
