A message from the team

- We hope that you have enjoyed your first week of Development Cycle 6. This year seems to have passed so quickly and it is incredible to think that there are just a few weeks until the end of this year.
- For most of you, this is the final term of your two-induction. Rather than having a progress review at the end of this term, you will therefore have your second (and final) formal endof-year assessment. The window for schools to complete this assessment is from 30th June until 21st July 2023. Prior to your assessment taking place, there is a short form for you to complete, asking you to outline your progress against each of the Teachers' Standards this year. Full details of the end-of-year assessment process and documentation can be found in the secure ECF Member Area of the Xavier website ECF Member Area. The email address you need to use to login is xavierecf@xavier.org.uk and the password is Xaviertsh. Once logged in, please navigate to the Induction Tutor Area and select the End of year assessments link, then open Guidance for ECT Formal Assessments.

- **Final assessments** For most Year 2 ECTs, the next assessment (due in July) is their final one. As mentioned on the first page of this bulletin, in preparation for their final assessment, ECTs are asked to complete a short form, outlining their progress against the Teachers' Standards. This might be something you may wish to help them with during your mentor meetings.

- Final assessments A gentle reminder that if, by this time in the term, you have any doubts that any of your ECTs will be able to successfully complete induction, the deadline for communicating this to us was half term. In order for us to support you as a school and your ECT, please contacts.hunter@xaviercet.org.uk this week.
- September registrations If you have ECTs who need registering for September 2023, please Registeryour interest here. We understand that at this point you might not know how many ECTs you may have in September. At this point, please just give your best estimate, which will inform Xavier's planning for 2023-24. The form can be completed again later in the year once you are certain of your numbers.
- **DfE Portal** In advance of the DfE portal opening for new September registrations. The DfE have asked us to communicate to schools the need for induction tutors' details to be up to date and accurate. If you are leaving your post or are new to role, please register as the induction tutor for your school on the DfE portal. All communication from the DfE and Teach First will be delivered to the details registered on the DfE portal. To ensure we capture all the information required in the most accurate manner could we please ask you to complete the ECF programme member changes form linked **here**. This will advise us of all the changes required and enable us to make the necessary amendments.

- ECT Manager clean up Please can you log on and check that the list of tutors/induction tutors registered for your school is up-to-date. Some schools have tutors registered who have left the school etc. Please note that each school should only have <u>one</u> induction tutor. Could you please also check that the email addresses of all your ECTs are their professional (school) addresses, rather than their personal ones. Please also ensure your Headteacher's name and information is current. Please update and check all the details on ECT Manager in preparation for the new year. - Mentor funding We have had some enquiries from induction tutors asking us to clarify the mentor funding for next year. As mentioned in last week's bulletins, mentors who will complete the two-year mentor programme this July will be classed as trained and are therefore not eligible to receive funding if they mentor again.
