A message from the team

First of all, may we take a moment to say huge

CONGRATULATIONS!

- Though your schools have until 21st July to complete your final assessments, we want to say an enormous well done for successfully completing induction! We hope that your ECT experience has been a positive one. We have met many of your over the course of the two years and have greatly enjoyed working with you. We are grateful for your mentors, induction tutors and the many facilitators in our partner schools who have trained, guided and supported you. Some of you will be mentors yourselves next year, so we will see you again in September. Some of you will be going into middle leadership – if you decide to undertake a National Professional Qualification (NPQ), either next year, or in the future, we look forward to working with you again.
- Induction certificates: Your induction tutor has been sent a certificate for you for successfully completing the Teach First/Xavier training programme, which we hope they will present when your final assessment has been completed! The official recognition of successfully completing induction, however, comes from the Teaching Regulation Agency, who keep records of all teachers who have completed induction. Message for your induction tutor

- Assessments: Please ensure that your assessments are completed and signed off by ECTs, induction tutors and headteachers by the end of term. This signature process needs to be complete before any of the reports come to us for reviewing. If an ECT is leaving your school, they should also download copies of all their assessments to take with them while they still have access to their school *ECT Manager* account. Please be aware that until this process is completed, we cannot 'unclaim' ECTs from our Appropriate Body. This will hold up the transition process for their new schools.
- Urgent action required registering new ECTs with Xavier: Thank you to those of you who kindly completed our *Expression of Interest form*, indicating how many new ECTs you will have in September. All new ECTs now need to be formally registered with Xavier. To formally register your new ECTs, please use the following link <u>2023-24</u> <u>ECT registration</u> You should have received an email with full details of the registration process for September. If you have not done so, please do get in touch.
- **Registering new ECTs on the DfE portal:** Hopefully, your school will now have received an email from the DfE, letting you know that their registration portal for September starters is now open. This email usually goes to headteachers, so please do ask your headteacher to let you know once they receive it. As was the case last year, schools must register their ECTs with both Xavier **and** the DfE. Please remember to register your ECTs and mentors with their correct <u>school</u> email addresses and not their personal ones. Please also remember to link each ECT to their correct mentor on the DfE portal.

• Changes to ECTs, mentors etc: At this time of year, there are often a number of staffing changes, eg ECTs and/or mentors might be moving schools, or staffing capacity may necessitate a change of induction tutor and/or mentor etc. It is vital that both Xavier and the DfE are kept up-to-date with those changes.

- Induction tutors must also make the changes on the <u>DfE portal</u> to ensure your school receives the correct funding and your programme members receive access to the My Teach First/Brightspace online learning platform.
