KEY MESSAGES FROM THE TEAM

- Welcome to Year 2 of your ECT induction programme and our new-look bulletin. We hope you have had a wonderful summer and are looking forward to the year ahead. We thought we would give you the first few days to settle in before sending this bulletin to you. We hope that the start of your term has been a positive one.
- As you may remember, in Year 2 training moves from Modules to Development Cycles. Although Development Cycle 1 does not officially start until Week 3 of term (w/c 18th September), we thought we would highlight some key information to help you to successfully navigate the year ahead.
- Throughout your induction, one of the most important sources of information is the secure **ECF Member Area** of the **Xavier Teaching School Hub** website. This can be accessed via the orange button at the top of the website landing page. The **ECF Member Area** is restricted to those who are on the programme, so please use the following login details:

Please try to listen to all of the recorded sessions by Monday 18th September, when the programme officially starts.

ECT SEMINARS

- Details of the times, dates and locations of all Year 2 seminars can be found in the [ECT 2 – Seminars](#) document in the *Induction* folder on the *ECF Member Area* of our website.
- In Year 2, ECTs are required to attend **six 90-minute seminars**. For ECTs in Primary and SEND settings, these will take the form of six separate sessions, which will be held face-to-face. However, because of the travel distances involved in some cases, this year the six Secondary/Sixth Form seminars are being combined into **3 x 3-hour (face-to-face) training afternoons**, one per term. The dates, times and locations of all seminars for the year can be found in the seminar booklet.

Primary and SEND

- As you know, if you are in a Primary or SEND school, you will continue to attend seminars at the same training school as last year. Just a reminder that, if you were in the St Anne's (Chertsey) cohort, you will be attending seminars this year at Pycroft Grange Primary School.

Secondary and Sixth Form

- If you teach in Secondary or Sixth Form provision, during Year 2 you will attend subject-specific seminars.

- ECTs who teach more than one subject should attend the subject hub which is most representative of their 2023-24 teaching timetable.
- **If your subject is not listed above**, please advise Alison Maingard (a.maingard@xaviercet.org.uk) which of the above subject hubs you feel would be most beneficial for you to attend. There are some curriculum subjects for which Teach First do not yet provide specialist materials. In these cases, please note that the core slides for all subject hubs are the same, with only the exemplification materials in each being subject-specific. Your seminar facilitator will be made aware of the subject you teach and will do all they can to make the seminars relevant to your needs.
- **English** and **Science** ECTs will note that there are two cohorts per subject, because of the numbers involved. Before the first seminar takes place, emails will be sent to English and Science ECTs to let them know the cohort to which they have been assigned. Cohorts will be determined by the geographical location of ECTs' schools.
- As attendance at the afternoon training sessions will require cover, mentors and induction tutors in particular should ensure that cover is arranged well in advance of the seminar dates – many thanks.

MENTOR INTERACTIONS (meetings and observations)

- In Year 2, mentor meetings are held **fortnightly**, rather than weekly. The focus of these meetings should be on the relevant Development Cycle. Full details will be included in the weekly bulletins.

BRIGHTSPACE SELF-DIRECTED STUDY

- Year 2 is far less prescriptive in nature than Year 1. At the start of each Development Cycle, ECTs are required to complete a self-directed study task on *Brightspace*. ECTs then work with their mentors to identify **one key area** of their practice which they would particularly like to develop during that half-term. Ideally, this should be related to the focus of the Development Cycle but, as we always say, there is flexibility in the programme, if needed. The Year 2 programme therefore adopts a more personalised approach than in Year 1.

- When they move into Year 2, ECTs will still be able to access Year 1 materials on *Brightspace*. For September 2023, Teach First has added a new optional Year 1 module, entitled **Excellent Teaching in Special Schools**. This module is designed to provide further support for ECTs working in special schools or those in mainstream working with pupils with more complex needs. The optional module covers the following areas:

- Communication and interaction
- Cognition and learning
- Social, emotional and mental health
- Sensory and/or physical needs
- Supporting behaviour in a special school
- Developing early communication
- Effective use of teaching assistants
- Assessment in a special school.

MESSAGES FOR MENTORS

- Thank you for taking on the role of being a mentor this year. Some of you may be completely new to the programme, and others fully-trained. Wherever you are in terms of your own training, the information below is current and hopefully useful. **If you are a fully-trained mentor (ie have completed two years of ECF mentor training), it is not a requirement for you to attend any training seminars this year, though you are most welcome to do so.**
- We will send you a bulletin every week, containing all you need to know. More than anyone else, your support is key to your ECT's success within the classroom and to their wellbeing.
- **INDUCTION:** On the *ECF Member Area* of the Xavier website, in the Induction folder, you will find a document entitled [Mentor 2 – Induction and training overview](#). This outlines your training for the year and also provides links to the recorded induction sessions you are required to complete.
- **MENTOR HANDBOOK:** Please note that there is **no mentor handbook** for Year 2. Rather, a Year 2 programme guide for mentors can be found in the [Handbooks and Guidance](#) folder on the *ECF Member Area*.
- **SEMINARS:** As will be explained in mentor seminar 1, in 2023-24 there is a change to Year 2 mentoring. Rather than attending half-termly training seminars, Year 2 mentors will only be required to attend **one 60-minute training seminar per term**. The details of these sessions, plus details of mandatory and optional self-directed study on *Brightspace*, are outlined in the *Mentor 2 – Induction and training overview* document (referenced above).

MESSAGES FOR INDUCTION TUTORS

Entitlements

- Induction tutors are responsible for ensuring that all ECTs receive their **statutory entitlements**. In their second year, ECTs are entitled to:
 - 5% ECT non-contact time, in addition to the 10% all teachers receive for PPA;
 - The support of a dedicated mentor, who meets with them fortnightly for approximately an hour to discuss their progress and to provide support;
 - The opportunity to observe expert practitioners, as outlined in the Development Cycle programme;
 - A programme of support offered by Teach First and Xavier, in the form of access to online self-study materials on Teach First's Brightspace learning platform, and three twilight seminars during the year;
 - The support of an induction tutor who oversees their support, engagement and progress;
 - Access to a dedicated Xavier team member. Year 2 ECTs and mentors should contact Alison Maingard (Administrator: a.maingard@xaviercet.org.uk) or Leanne Fullbrook (Year 2 lead: l.fullbrook@xaviercet.org.uk).
